SEXUAL HEALTH

Apunipima offers sexual health promotion within our communities under the Commonwealth's <u>Fifth National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander BBV and STI Strategy 2018-2022</u>. This is an exciting project which builds upon Apunipima's work in sexual health in both clinical, research and health promotion capacities. Our aim is to improve access to sexual health services for young people in Cape York communities.

Currently we are working with three communities: Napranum, Kowanyama and Aurukun. In collaboration with youth and other services providers we are developing educational material for social media to improve Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander youth knowledge and awareness of STIs and BBVs in Cape York communities. We are also delivering sexual health education sessions to Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander youth who reside in Cape York communities
